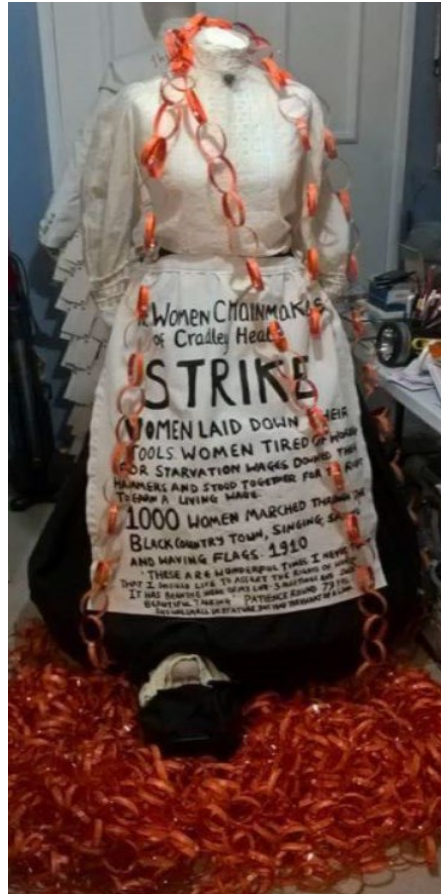


Celebrating International Women's Week 2018 in Portsmouth

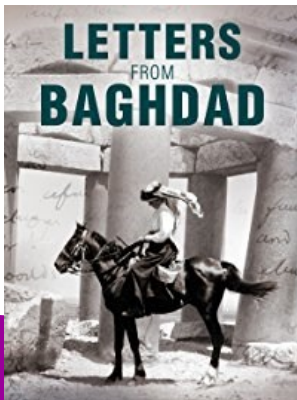
Letters From Baghdad
